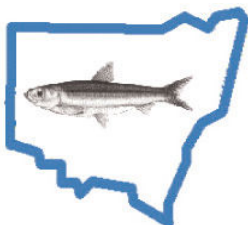
ANGFA also has a presence in several Australian states. Join your nearest club for the opportunity to show you care. All membership money will be forwarded on your behalf.
